- The Profit before Tax for the current quarter is Rs.3102 lakhs compared to Rs.3588 lakhs for the corresponding quarter of the previous year.
- The Profit after Tax for the current quarter is Rs.2435 lakhs compared to Rs.2699 lakhs for the corresponding quarter of the previous year.
- 4. Exceptional Items for the corresponding quarter of the previous year ended 30th June, 2016 of Rs.231 lakhs represents expenditure on certain long term initiatives.
- 5. Produce growing on Bearer plants is a Biological asset and is fair valued based on the biological transformation. As Coffee and Pepper go through Biological transformation, the same are fair valued only when the growth can be measured reliably. In the current quarter since they are in early stage of transformation, the growth cannot be reliably estimated and hence has not been fair valued and are measured at its cost.
- 6. Pursuant to the approval granted by the Board of Directors on 19th December, 2016, for setting up of a state-of-the-art greenfield Freeze Dried Instant Coffee facility in Vietnam, the Company has, during the current quarter, infused in aggregate an amount of USD 6 Million (Rs.3877 Lakhs) in the equity capital of its wholly owned subsidiary "Tata Coffee Vietnam Company Limited", Vietnam.
- 7. The Statement includes the results for the quarter ended 31st March, 2017 being the balancing figure of the audited figures in respect of the previous financial year and the published year to date figures upto the third quarter of the previous financial year, which were subjected to limited review.
- 8. The aforementioned results were reviewed by the Audit Committee of the Board and subsequently approved by the Board of Directors at its Meeting held on 27th July, 2017. The results for the quarter ended 30th June, 2017 have been audited.

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REVIEW REPORT ON REVIEW OF INTERIM FINANCIAL RESULTS

TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TATA COFFEE LIIMITED

1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Consolidated Unaudited Financial Results of **TATA COFFEE LIMITED** ("the Parent") and its subsidiaries (the Parent and its subsidiaries together referred to as "the Group") for the Quarter ended June 30, 2017 ("the Statement") being submitted by the Parent pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as modified by Circular No. CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated July 5, 2016.

This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Parent's Management and approved by the Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to issue a report on the Statement based on our review.

- 2. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This Standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the Statement is free of material misstatement. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of Parent's personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provides less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and, accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.
- 3. The Statement includes the results of the following entities:
 - a. Consolidated Coffee Inc. and its subsidiaries Eight O Clock Holdings Inc. and Eight O Clock Coffee Company.
 - b. Tata Coffee Vietnam Company Limited
- 4. Based on our review conducted as stated above and based on the consideration of the review reports of the other auditors referred to in paragraph 5 below, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as modified by Circular No. CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated July 5, 2016, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.



5. We did not review the interim financial information of 4 subsidiaries included in the consolidated unaudited financial results, whose interim financial information reflect total revenues of Rs. 18629 lakhs for the quarter ended June 30, 2017, and total profit after tax of Rs.2056 lakhs and total comprehensive income of Rs. 497 lakhs for the quarter ended June 30, 2017, as considered in the consolidated unaudited financial results. These interim financial information have been reviewed by other auditors and our report on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries is based solely on the reports of the other auditors.

Our report on the Statement is not modified in respect of this matter.
